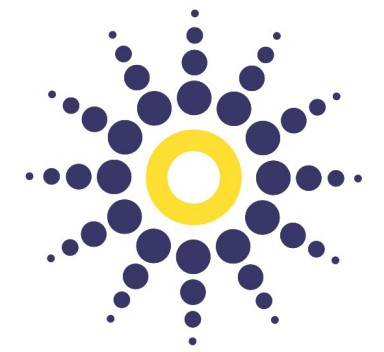

- I. Attitude or Amount?
 - A formula?
 - It is not about how much you sow/give, it is the manner in which you sow/give.
 - The situation in Corinth.
- II. A Work of Heart.
 - The heart is the starting place.
 - Contrasts: Generously/Blessingly vs. Reluctantly/Miserly
 - Not concerned with return, concerned with effect on others
 - God loves a cheerful giver – God loves those who sow to bless others.
- III. Sow What?
 - How is your heart?
 - What and how are you sowing?
 - Self-examination.
