March was Minnesota FoodShare month and were able to team up with CEAP (Community Emergency Assistance Program) to gather and donate both food and funds.

Our Northern Light Family donated over 1600 pounds of food and \$ 2,000.07!

The Minneapolis Greater Council of Churches and Minnesota FoodShare matches these donations in various ways.

The food donations are matched at least 1:1.

Due to the economy of scale, price breaks, etc., the monetary donations will be matched at a ratio of somewhere between 5:1 and 10:1, depending on their total amount collected.

In simple terms, our donations are being multiplied in HUGE ways...our \$2,000 will purchase between \$10,000 and \$20,000 worth of food for hungry Minnesotans!
