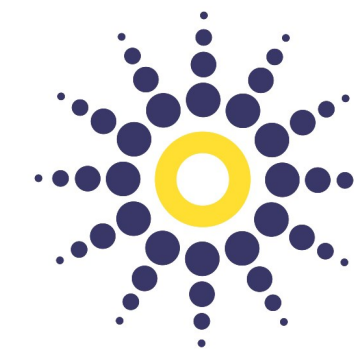

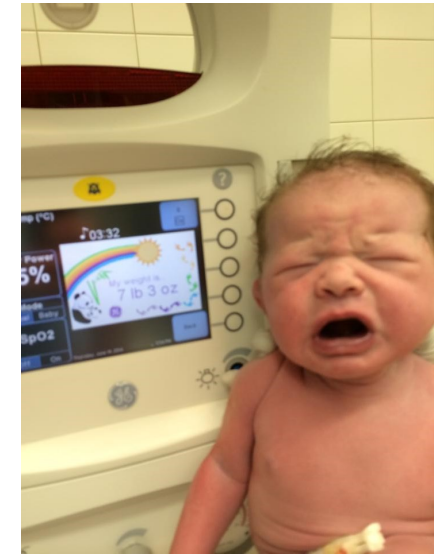
If you would like to help prepare the communion or clean up the kitchen after our Sunday morning service, please either jot a note on your attendance card or see Melissa.
