<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teach an adult Bible class—usually a rotation— Sunday morning or Wednesday evening 	Dave Ward
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lead a worship service at Tradition (the assisted living facility across the street) —2nd Sunday of each month 	David Dotson
