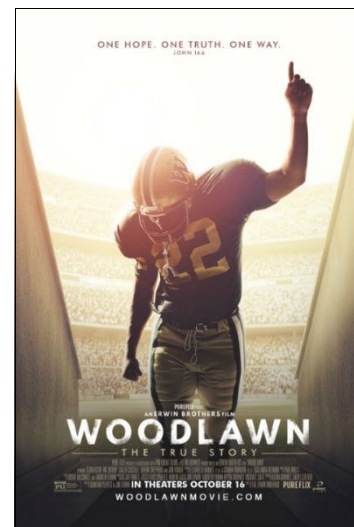
In the Grip of Grace
