Reflections from Ronnie

Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, partners in a heavenly calling, take note of Jesus, the apostle and high priest whom we confess, who is faithful to the one who appointed him, as Moses was also in God’s house. For he has come to deserve greater glory than Moses, just as the builder of a house deserves greater honor than the house itself! For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God.

Reflections:  
Remember today that Jesus Christ was faithful to God the Father in all that He accomplished—even death on the cross. God’s design for us is to be in relationship with Him and, through the life, death, and resurrection of Christ, He has built the bridge necessary for us to be in that relationship with Him. Our salvation has been made possible by God himself. The Son does what He sees the Father doing (John 5:19—paraphrased).

That bridge being Jesus Christ, taking us from a self will life, towards a God will life of Unity with God. Remember this week that God’s anger is anything that divides his Children and destroys them.
