Dave Ward will present the building and property, support and development and finance reports for 2021. He will also give us the update on budgets for 2022. After his presentation, we will have a question and answer period.

We will then elect or reelect our Trustee. Ralph Weber's Trustee term will expire this year.

Education Ministry Group (Group Lead: Melissa Ward)

The addition of Zoom and Facebook video streaming has opened up new possibilities for those who can't drive at night, can't attend due to work schedules, and even those throughout the country. We have people from coast to coast viewing and/or participating in our classes! Our traditional Sunday morning Bible classes for children and teens began again in September.

Fellowship Ministry Group (Group Lead: Emem Akpan)

A positive thing, which was necessitated by COVID, is that each person is warmly greeted as they come through the door. The welcome team continues with greeting members/visitors as they come through the door. The back to Church celebration was successful. Moreover, we have continued our support to the Flaming Pine Youth Camp (FPYC).
