II. AN OVERVIEW OF DANIEL 9:1-27

1. Daniel sets the scene (v.1-2)

This entire land will become a desolate wasteland. Israel and her neighboring lands will serve the king of Babylon for seventy years. "Then, after the seventy years of captivity are over, I will punish the king of Babylon and his people for their sins," says the LORD. "I will make the country of the Babylonians a wasteland forever. I will bring upon them all the terrors I have promised in this book—all the penalties announced by Jeremiah against the nations. Many nations and great kings will enslave the Babylonians, just as they enslaved my people. I will punish them in proportion to the suffering they cause my people."

Jeremiah 25:11-14 (NLT)

This is what the LORD says: "You will be in Babylon for seventy years. But then I will come and do for you all the good things I have promised, and I will bring you home again.
