As you may know, Linda Bagley's sister (Joyce Bagley's daughter) Carole, her son Kenny Bergemann and granddaughter Keira had their home damaged by lightning about a month ago. The lightning struck a tree near the house, then entered the house through a vent and caused considerable damage. The ceiling completely collapsed and they are trying to determine whether it actually raised the roof of the walls in some places. They are truly fortunate to be alive. Of course, the home is uninhabitable and will take months to repair.

The family is living in a hotel right now and will be moving into a rental home soon - but is still "wrestling" with the insurance company over the settlement.

One thing it appears insurance will not cover is the removal of the tree that was struck. It is a cottonwood that is 160 feet tall, 24 feet around and over 350 years old. Ken said that the lowest bid they received for removing it was \$17,000.
