I. THE IMPORTANCE OF RELATIONSHIPS TO MY FAITH

II. WAYS I CAN TRANSFORM MY RELATIONSHIPS FOR GOOD -ROMANS 12:1-21

- 1. I must transform my relationship with God (v.1-2)
 - By choosing to give myself completely to Him (v.1)
 - By allowing Him to radically change my thinking and behavior (v.2)
- 2. I must transform my relationships with other believers (v.3-16)
 - By honestly assessing my own strengths and weaknesses (v.3)
 - By faithfully using my gifts to strengthen the Body of Christ (v.4-16)
 I do that by...
 - ⇒ Living generously (v.4-8)
 - ⇒ Living differently (v.9-16)
- 3. I must transform my relationship with my enemies (v.17-21)
 - Don't:
 - ⇒ Repay evil for evil
 - ⇒ Take revenge
