. THE CONNECTION BETWEEN PSALM 23 AND JOHN 10

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

He maketh me to lie down in green pastures:

he leadeth me beside the still waters.

He restoreth my soul:

he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death,

I will fear no evil: for thou art with me;

thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies:

II. JESUS CONTINUES TO REVEAL HIS IDENTITY—JOHN 10:1-42

1. I am the Gate of the sheep (v.1-10)

2. I am the Good Shepherd (v.11-21)

3. I am the Son of God (v.22-42)
