REASONS WHY I CAN REPLACE MY PANIC WITH GOD'S PEACE—JOHN 14:1-31

1. I know God is still in control (v.1)

2. I know my future is secure (v.2-3)

Some things to remember about Heaven

Heaven is beyond my comprehension

That is what the Scriptures mean when they say, "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him."

1 Corinthians 2:9 (NLT)

Heaven is an actual place – not just a state of mind

We know that if the life we live here on earth is ever taken down like a tent, we still have a building from God. It is an eternal house in heaven that isn't made by human hands.

2 Corinthians 5:1 (GOD'S WORD)

Heaven has none of the things that trouble me on earth

He will wipe away all tears from their eyes, and there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying, nor pain. All of that has gone forever."

Revelation 21:4 (TLB)

Heaven is an eternal reunion with believing loved ones

Six days later, Jesus took Peter, James, and John, the brother of James, up on a high mountain by themselves. While they watched, Jesus' appearance was changed; his face became bright like the sun, and his clothes became white as light. Then Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Jesus. Heaven is where I see Jesus face to face

My dear friends, we are now God's children, but it is not yet clear what we shall become. But we know that when Christ appears, we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he really is.

1 John 3:2 (TEV)

3. I know how to get where Jesus is going (v.4-11)

4. I know the power of prayer (v.12-14)

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us.

1 John 5:14 (NIV)

5. I know I'm not alone

Don't you know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit? The Spirit is in you. You have received him from God. You do not belong to yourselves.

1 Corinthians 6:19 (NIRV)

6. I know the importance of obedience

The LORD confides in those who fear him; he makes his covenant known to them.

Psalm 25:14 (NIV)

7. I know my victory is guaranteed

Yet what we suffer now is nothing compared to the glory he will reveal to us later.

Romans 8:18 (NLT)
