- 2. Prayer is designed to deepen my friendship with God**

A-C-T-S Method of Organizing Prayer

A = Adoration

C = Confession

T = Thanksgiving

S = Supplication

- 1. Himself (v.1-5)**

- 2. His disciples (v.6-19)**
