II. HOW DID I GO FROM A MESS TO A MASTERPIECE? - EPHESIANS 2:1-10

My...

- 1. Predicament without Christ (v.1-3)
 - Spiritually dead in sin
 - Living the ways of the world
 - Ruled by the devil
