THE PROBLEMS OF PREJUDICE AND DIVISION

Racism is not a skin problem – it is a sin problem Unknown

II. HOW THE GOSPEL OVERCOMES PREJUDICES

1. Jesus came to save all people

God loved the people of this world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who has faith in him will have eternal life and never really die.

John 3:16 (CEV)

2. Jesus came to create an entirely new people

For Christ himself has brought peace to us. He united Jews and Gentiles into one people when, in his own body on the cross, he broke down the wall of hostility that separated us. He did this by ending the system of law with its commandments and regulations. He made peace between Jews and Gentiles by creating in himself one new people from the two groups. Together as one body, Christ reconciled both groups to God by means of his death on the cross, and our hostility toward each other was put to death.
