



I. THE DESTRUCTIVE CYCLE OF SIN CONTINUES



II. REASONS GOD CAN USE THE ORDINARY TO DO THE EXTAORDINARY-JUDGES 6-7

- 1. God uses tough times to get my attention (6:1-6)
- 2. God sees potential that I can't (v.7-12)
- 3. God provides the strength that I don't have (v.13-24)
- 4. God patiently waits for my faith to grow (v.25-40)

5. God gives me victory against overwhelming enemies (7:1-25)
Each time he said, "My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness." So now I am glad to boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ can work through me. That's why I take pleasure in my weaknesses, and in the insults, hardships, persecutions, and troubles that I suffer for Christ. For when I am weak, then I am strong. 2 Corinthians 12:9-10 (NLT)
III. WINNING THE BATTLE—BUT LOSING THE WAR—JUDGES 8
For every one hundred men who can stand adversity there is only one who can withstand prosperity Thomas Carlyle
1. Gideon tactfully responds to the Ephraimites (v.1-3)
1. Clacon tactionly responds to the Epinanintes (v. 1 0)
2. Gideon disciplines some doubters (v.4-17)
3. Gideon takes revenge on the enemy kings (v.18-21)
4. Gideon starts living like a king (v.22-23, 29-31)
5. Gideon leads Israel into idolatry (v.24-28)

6. Gideon leaves a tainted legacy (v.32-35)
