. THE IMPORTANCE OF MY WORDS

- 1. A culture of lies and liars:
 - About 60% of people 18 and older are incapable of having a conversation without lying once every ten minutes
 - On average, adults tell three lies every ten minutes
 - 86% of lies are told to parents
 - Most people (about 75%) tell zero to two lies per day.
 - Men lie 6 times a day on average, while women lie 3 times a day on average*

II. JEPHTHAH: A GREAT WARRIOR WHO MADE A FOOLISH VOW – JUDGES 10-11

- 1. A nation in trouble (10:1-18)
 - Israel was ungrateful (v.1-5)
 - Israel was disobedient (v.6-16)
 - Israel was lacking godly leaders (v.17-18)
- 2. A great warrior (11:1-29)

Jephthah was...

• Rejected by his family (v.1-3a)

Instead, God chose things the world considers foolish in order to shame those who think they are wise. And he chose things that are powerless to shame those who are powerful. God chose things despised by the world, things counted as nothing at all, and used them to bring to nothing what the world considers important. As a result, no one can ever boast in the presence of God.

- 3. A regretful father (11:29-40)
 - A rash vow (v.29-31)
 - A painful sacrifice (v.32-40)

III. REASONS TO PRAY BEFORE WE SPEAK OR MAKE ANY VOWS

1.	Make sure I am following scripture and not culture
2.	Don't make rash vows Don't trap yourself by making a rash promise to God and only later counting the cost. Proverbs 20:25 (NLT)
3.	I don't need to make these kinds of deals with God
4.	"You have also heard that our ancestors were told, 'You must not break your vows; you must carry out the vows you make to the LORD.' But I say, do not make any vows! Do not say, 'By heaven!' because heaven is God's throne. And do not say, 'By the earth!' because the earth is his footstool. And do not say, 'By Jerusalem!' for Jerusalem is the city of the great King. Do not even say, 'By my head!' for you can't turn one hair white or black. Just say a simple, 'Yes, I will,' or 'No, I won't.' Anything beyond this is from the evil one Matthew 5:33-37 (NLT)
