



## I. THE NIGHT THAT CHANGED EVERYTHING: THE FINAL PLAGUE AND THE EXODUS—EXODUS 11-13

1. The prediction of the final plague (11:1-2).
2. God is always many steps ahead of us in implementing His plan (v.3).

When people's lives please the LORD, even their enemies are at peace with them.

### 3. How the events of the plague and the exodus will unfold (v.4-8).

- All the firstborns in Egypt will die (v.5).
- There will be tremendous grief throughout the land (v.6).
- Israel will be protected (v.7).
- The Israelites will leave Egypt in a mass exodus (v.8).

### 4. God's instructions in preparation for Israel to leave Egypt (12:1-33).

- The establishment of the Passover (v.1-10).
- The rewards of obedience (v.11-13).
- The urgency of being ready to travel (v.14-15).
- The final plague arrives (v.28-33).

## II. WHAT WE LEARN FROM THIS PART OF MOSES' LIFE

1. \_\_\_\_\_ God guides—He Provides. Where He leads—He supplies the needs.

He brought the people of Israel out of Egypt. The Egyptians loaded them down with silver and gold. From among the tribes of Israel no one got tired or fell down. The Egyptians were glad when the people of Israel left. They were terrified because of Israel. The Lord spread out a cloud to cover his people. He gave them a fire to light up the night. They asked for meat, and he brought them quail. He satisfied them with manna, the bread of heaven... His chosen people shouted for joy as he brought them out of Egypt.

And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:19 (NLT)

2. \_\_\_\_\_ is the key to freedom and success.

Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do.

3. All of these events point to the \_\_\_\_\_ we receive through the blood of “the lamb” - Jesus Christ.

For the life of the body is in its blood. I have given you the blood on the altar to purify you, making you right with the LORD. It is the blood, given in exchange for a life, that makes purification possible.

Leviticus 17:11 (NLT)

In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.

Hebrews 9:22 (NIV)

For it is not possible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins. That is why...Christ came into the world...

Hebrews 10:4-5a (NLT)

For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.

1 Corinthians 5:7 (NCV)

Rather, the payment that freed you was the precious blood of Christ, the lamb with no defects or imperfections.

1 Peter 1:19 (GOD'S WORD)

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

4. The \_\_\_\_\_ is our “Passover Memorial Meal” that reminds us of what Christ has done for us.

He took some bread and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and gave it to the disciples, saying, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me.” After supper he took another cup of wine and said, “This cup is the new covenant between God and his people—an agreement confirmed with my blood, which is poured out as a sacrifice for you.

Luke 22:19-20 (NLT)

Christian communion, like the Passover, is a [memorial] event! As the bread and wine are passed, a door in time opens, and as we pass through we find ourselves standing at the foot of the cross. We see Christ’s agony, we are stained by the blood He shed, and we realize, “Christ died for me!”

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
