### **I. THREE TRUTHS TO REMEMBER THROUGH MY FEARS**

## **II. HOW I CAN BE FREE FROM MY FEAR OF FINANCIAL PROBLEMS - MATTHEW 6:19-34**

### **1. Choose the right Lord (v.19-24)**

- **Value Him more than money (v.19-21)**
- **Seek Him more than money (v.22-23)**
- **Serve Him more than money (v.24)**

### **2. Magnify my God instead of my fears (v.25-28)**

### **3. Give the Lord first place in every area of my life (v.33-34)**
