

WHAT IS A BREAKTHROUGH?

A breakthrough is a significant and sudden advancement, resolving of a problem, getting past a barrier, overcoming an obstacle, or conquering an enemy.*

II. HOW CAN I EXPERIENCE A BREAKTHROUGH?—2 CHRONICLES 20:1-30

1. PRAY: Asking God for His breakthrough power (v.3-13)

Key components of "breakthrough prayer":

- Remember who my God is (v.6)
- Recall the times that God has been there for me in the past (v.7a)
- Remind God of the promises He has made (v.7b-9)

"And now, LORD, let the promise you have made concerning your servant and his house be established forever. Do as you promised...
