- 3. Jacob sends expensive gifts to hopefully appease Esau (v.13-21)
- 4. Jacob wrestles with God (v.22-32)

III. WHAT I LEARN FROM JACOB ABOUT BEING GREATLY USED BY GOD

1. Realize that the only thing that will limit an unlimited God in my life - is my self-reliance

You will not succeed by your own strength or power, but by my Spirit,' says the LORD All-Powerful.

Zechariah 4:6 (NCV)

2. Understand that sometimes God must break me of my self-dependance

Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.

1 Peter 5:6-7 (ESV)

3. Admit who and what I am before God

But his answer was: "My grace is all you need, for my power is greatest when you are weak." I am most happy, then, to be proud of my weaknesses, in order to feel the protection of Christ's power over me. I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and difficulties for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

4. Know that the Lord will give me a new identity with new potential

5. Resolve that in my brokenness—the blessing will be found by clinging to God.
