I. WHAT IS WORSHIP?

Worship is having reverence, showing adoration and giving praise to something or someone because that person or object is important or honorable.

- 1. Worship is directing my attention to God
- 2. Worship is my response to God's love and greatness (See Ephesians 1:3-11)

Jesus replied, "You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment.

III. HOW DOES WORSHIP EMPOWER MY SPIRITUAL GROWTH?

1. Worship brings me into the presence of God

2. Worship renews my joy and strength

I was glad when they said to me, "Let us go to the house of the LORD."
